Re: CASE 13-T-0538 - Application of Williams Field Services Company, LLC and DMP New York, Inc. For a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need to Construct an Approximately 9.5-Mile Natural Gas Gathering Pipeline in the Town of Windsor, Broome County, State of New York.

Dear Secretary Burgess:

Williams Field Services Company, LLC and DMP New York, Inc. (collectively, "Williams"), is providing the New York ("NY") Public Service Commission (the "Commission") an update concerning a May 20, 2014, site visit conducted in connection with the captioned matter. The site visit was held on the proposed New York Mainline Loop Natural Gas Pipeline Project ("Project") right-of-way ("ROW") with representatives from the NY Department of Public Service ("NYDPS"), the NY Department of Agriculture and Markets ("NYDAM") and Williams. The purpose of the site visit was to determine if the proposed temporary access road (AR-1A), located on the Scott Property (#229.04-1-25.2), could be classified as an active agricultural land. Upon further review, it was determined that AR-1A does cross land that could be classified as a hay field and the construction of AR-1A will need to be treated with the same regard as construction activities on other active agricultural land along the

Project. For the purposes of construction and restoration, Williams agrees to treat the land actually crossed by AR-1A on the Scott Property as an active hay field and will implement top soil segregation and subsoil decompaction construction techniques. Should this Project receive approval, Williams recommends the Commission include an ordering clause in the certificate to document this change.
