Re: Permits Requested by Robert P. Coughlin of RPC Resources, LLC, Blue Stone Quarry, Inc., c/o Charles Capasso, James Colpitts

This will follow up our phone conversation on August 6, 2014. As we discussed, any recommendations to the DEC regarding permits will come from the Town Supervisor after the Town Board has discussed concerns from the Planning Board, which is advisory.

In the case of the three permits cited above, it is appropriate that people requesting permits are made aware of any applicable Town Laws. We would rather have people aware of Town Laws so they can follow these laws.

What must be disregarded is the Planning Board stating that the Highway Superintendent should consider a bond for potential damage from the impact of truck travel on town roads. This is a matter that would have to be discussed by the Town Board and approved by the Town Board.

The other matter that should be disregarded is the Planning Board stating that stone hauling on Town roads should be limited from 6 to 9 am and 2:30 to 5 pm.
