**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Part 617 of the implementing regulations pertaining to Article 8 (State Environmental Quality Review Act)(“SEQRA”), it has been determined by the Windsor Town Board that adoption of the proposed Local Law does not constitute an action as defined and could be considered without further regard to SEQRA, and

**WHEREAS**, the Windsor Town Board, after due deliberation, finds it in the best interest of the Town to adopt said Local Law, and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Windsor Town Board hereby adopts said Local Law as Local Law No. 3-2013 entitled **SEWER INSTALLATION AND USE LAW**”; and a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, and

**THEREFORE**, the Town Clerk be and she hereby is directed to enter said Local Law in the minutes of this meeting and to give due notice of the adoption of said Local Law to the Secretary of State.
