ARTICLE I

Appearance Tickets

§ 17-1. Purpose.

The purpose of this local law is to authorize public servants of the Town of Windsor to issue and serve appearance tickets in connection with the violations of state statutes, local laws, parking regulations, ordinances, or rules and regulations of said Town which the public servants are authorized or required to enforce.

§ 17-2. Authority to issue.[Amended 4-2-97, LL No.1-1997]

The following public servants of the Town of Windsor are hereby authorized to issue and serve appearance tickets with respect to a violation of a state statute, a local law, ordinance, rule or regulation of the Town of Windsor that such public servants are, respectively, required or authorized to enforce.:

- (a) Building Inspector - Building, zoning, planning matters.
- (b) Code Enforcement Officer - All local laws and ordinances of the Town of Windsor.
- (c) Dog Control Officer - Article 7 of the Agriculture and Markets Law of the State of New

and leashing of dogs.

- d. Such other public servants authorized to issue and serve appearance tickets by the Laws of the State of New York. [Amended 4-2-97, LL No.1-1997]

**§ 17-3. Service of Appearance Tickets.**

An appearance ticket other than for a parking violation shall be served personally. Parking appearance tickets shall be considered validly served if placed or affixed to the offending vehicle.

**§ 17-4. When effective.**

This chapter shall take effect immediately upon the filing in the office of the Secretary of State.
