Windsor town garage project. Building is 100x54. Convert 70x54 into conditioned workspace. The exterior walls are 14 feet to the top plate, and it is 23-feet to the ridge. Gable ends are 9-feet tall. A demising wall will be constructed at the 70-foot mark of the building. An appendage breakroom and lavatory will be stick framed at a size of 12x18 off the back left.

Scope of work may to include applying closed cell spray foam on the exterior wall sections, roof deck and gable end.

This is a prevailing wage project. A lift is included in this proposal. Fall protection and PPE required.

#### 1. Accessibility & Personal Belongings:
