ing and code restrictions on lot sizes. Her idea is to down-size with both property purchase and house size. Deputy Supervisor Dan Colwell explained that with new builds, Broome County requires enough property for a main septic system and a replacement septic system, with an end result determining the minimum property size. There was discussion on the possibilities of building on property with a ready septic system, property setbacks and definitions and codes for tiny houses. It was Ms. Olmsted's night because she got some free advice from a builder, the town engineer, and the town attorney.

Also during Public Comments, Daniel Price shared that he had just attended a meeting on transportation needs of people in rural areas sponsored by Office for Aging. Price said hospitals/med centers needed to have some way of scheduling medical appointments so seriously ill people did not have to accept transportation at 8AM in the morning and remain stranded until 4PM in the afternoon. He said this area needs to have some kind of correlation so that hospitals get together and schedule the different services at the same time. Price who has recovered from a cancer bout, used himself as an example. "He was treated at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center. Through Operation Angel, sponsored by Corning, I would go to Elmira and be flown to Sloan. I would arrive at 11AM. Those people knew that, so they never scheduled appointments or treatments before 11AM. He said people in urban areas have options-public transportation, taxi service, walkable communities. People in rural areas do not have those options. "You have a lot of elderly people and it is almost impossible for them to make these appointments. Price asked for ideas on how rural residents could be better served and how hospitals could coordinate appointments.
