Supervisor Odell,

Eastern Broome Emergency Services is respectfully requesting our “additional consideration funding” as identified in Section 6(b) of our agreement. The \$10,000 will be used toward the purchase of our new 2022 Crestline CCL150 Type 3 Chevy G3500 Ambulance that was purchased from Northeastern Rescue Vehicles.

“As additional consideration, Town may provide Squad from the Town’s fund balance in amount not to exceed \$10,000.00. The Town’s failure or delay in making this additional allocation available to Squad shall not constitute a breach or default under this Agreement. This additional consideration is a one-time allocation to assist the Squad with a one-time, non-operating expense or a one-time deposit in Squad’s Savings account to bridge a gap due to billing cash flow. The Squad shall identify to the Town how the money will be used before payment is made.”

The total cost of the ambulance is \$168,745. Below is a break down of funding being used to cover the cost of this ambulance:

Capital Reserve / Earmarked grant Funding Account: \$81,147.02

Fundraiser Account: \$13,852.98

Savings Account: \$33,745.00

Town of Windsor Additional Consideration: \$10,000.00

Broome County Grant (Awarded / Not In Account): \$30,000.00

Our business plan calls for replacing an ambulance every 5 years. Our last new ambulance was purchased in 2018 and has almost 100,000 miles on it already. This new ambulance will be replacing our 2006 ambulance which has over 100,000 miles on it and is currently out of service due to mechanical issues.
