Rensselaer and Polly are buried in this Cemetery in the family plot near their former home.	X

Sutliff, Minerva T. Wilcox	1826 - Aug. 2, 1882	56		born in Conn. Wife of Emory William Sutliff. Her gravestone was dug up years ago and photographed by Robert H. Albert, a descendant. Death date may be July 7, 1882.	X
