Barney Osborne, the Windsor Town Historian, wrote about the Higley Cemetery. The Higley Farm Cemetery is located on top of the high bank south of the Occanum Creek on John Hieumier's farm. This farm used to belong to Roswell Higley from about 1796 - 1834. Roswell and his wife, Sarah Garnsey were buried there. Every Spring in years past part of the bank would slide into the creek, taking graves and stones with it. There is a large area of side hill covered with trees, that once was level ground and on a high elevation. Windsor Standard Sept. 10, 1964. Long forgotten cemetery found near Occanum Creek. Mr. & Mrs. Paul L. Hoosier of Occanum Creek Farm discovered a cemetery located some distance north of Occanum Creek bridge on Hoadley Hill Rd. Mr. Hoosier said that they located the old burying ground, which is on top of the bank by the swimming hole, after hearing that there was such a place somewhere in the area. He said that there are at least fifteen graves and that all of the stones had been turned face down to the ground, erasing much of the engraving. He mentioned that one small stone bore the letters "D.H.S." and another stone had the date 1811 and the words "13 years, 10 months," apparently the grave of a child. Another stone was engraved with "Hannah, his wife, died Dec. 23, 1846, age 79 years and 2 months."
