For the month of June: I was organizing my office from the crazy few months before and filing the final assessment roll. The Final Assessment Roll came out July 1<sup>st</sup> and it's in my office for review.

In the middle of July, I went to two different classes at Cornell University. The New York State Assessor's Association puts on week-long classes in Ithaca every July. It's a great way to get your continuing education and talk to other assessors in the state. NYS sent out income worksheets to my seniors that don't file an income tax return. NYS was trying to find out their income so that can receive the Enhanced STAR check or exemption, so I had a lot of calls for that when I got back from class. Some taxpayers were making sure it really was from NYS or was it a scam. It was a simple form they had to fill out and send back to them. I also had a couple people ask for an assessment or taxes quote, they might be building a new home or deck or something and want to know what their taxes might be.
