We continue to partner with Windsor CSD Varsity Athletics for various camps and clinics to build ongoing relationships between coaches as well as provide mentoring and growth opportunities for young athletes.

 Highlights of this partnership include our Biddy Bouncers program that had over 125 young athletes and 18

Klumpp Park baseball field fencing was done prior to Opening Day. The fencing looks great and there is additional space around the concession area for families to watch games.

The First 8U Baseball Tournament was held mid July. Great feedback from those who coordinated the tournament with the goal of expanding to the 10U and 12U levels next summer.

Games were played under the softball lights for the first time for both regular season and summer! This comes after the project that was finished last year in partnership with a grant through the Village of Windsor.

Upcoming Projects:

Klumpp Park playground upgrade: Looking into grants to support new equipment.

Softball field regrading: receiving quotes on regrading field to help with standing water making the field unplayable.

Picnic Tables: Partnering with WCSD Manufacturing Economics course to build picnic tables (materials supplied by WYSR) to place in the area surrounding the concession stand, with each table being dedicated in memory of a community member.

Past ideas include the Concession Stand Wall: Partnering with a current Mosaic Tile Artist to complete a mosaic wall on the side of the concession stand. Currently looking into grant funding and a possible partnership with the school for students to be a part of it.

WYSR would like to once again thank you for your continued support of our events and programs.
