**Old South Windsor Grange Hall
and One-room Schoolhouse, plus
Historic Marker at Boyhood Home
of George Catlin, 19th Century Painter
of Native Americans in the West**
Route 79 just south of Edson Rd., S. Windsor
Open 9 AM to 2 PM

This historic building has served the community for over 100 years and is presently in the process of being restored. The history of the schoolhouse, grange hall and the remarkable life of George Catlin will be on display. Mr. Catlin spent his boyhood in the early 1800s collecting Indian artifacts on the family farm in South Windsor. He went out West in the 1830s to paint the indigenous people of this country. His paintings are in the Smithsonian Institute.

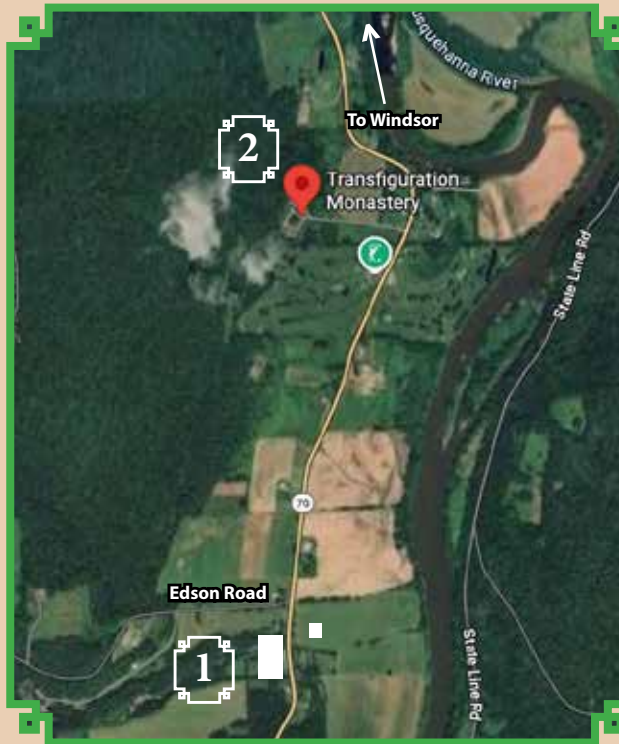
Transfiguration Monastery

In 1909, James Elliott, formerly a salesman for the Coburn Whip Factory, began the Windsor Whip Works in the building that is there today. The last whip-making company in Windsor, they were in production until 1948. In all, Windsor had manufactured whips for 97 years.
